Hampton Roads Post Awards- Author of the Year- Young Member

LT Todd Wimmer is recommended for the Hampton Roads Post award for Author of the Year for his submission of an article titled "Public-Sector Multiple Award Construction Contracts" published in The Military Engineer-Online Exclusive, November-December 2009 Vol 101, Number 662. This article was a brief synopsis of LT Wimmer's larger thesis that earned him a Master's in Civil Engineering at the University of Colorado, Boulder. In the article, LT Wimmer summarizes advantages and characteristics of 24 different multiple award contracts currently used by the US Coast Guard, US Navy, US Air Force, and US Army Corps of Engineers. He provides reference to the best practices guide published by the Government Office of Management and Budget. The article does not serve as a best practices guide, but rather offers a brief insight into the current state of practice and characteristics of contracts being used across various branches of the government. LT Wimmer is available to discuss in great detail specificity surrounding his research.
