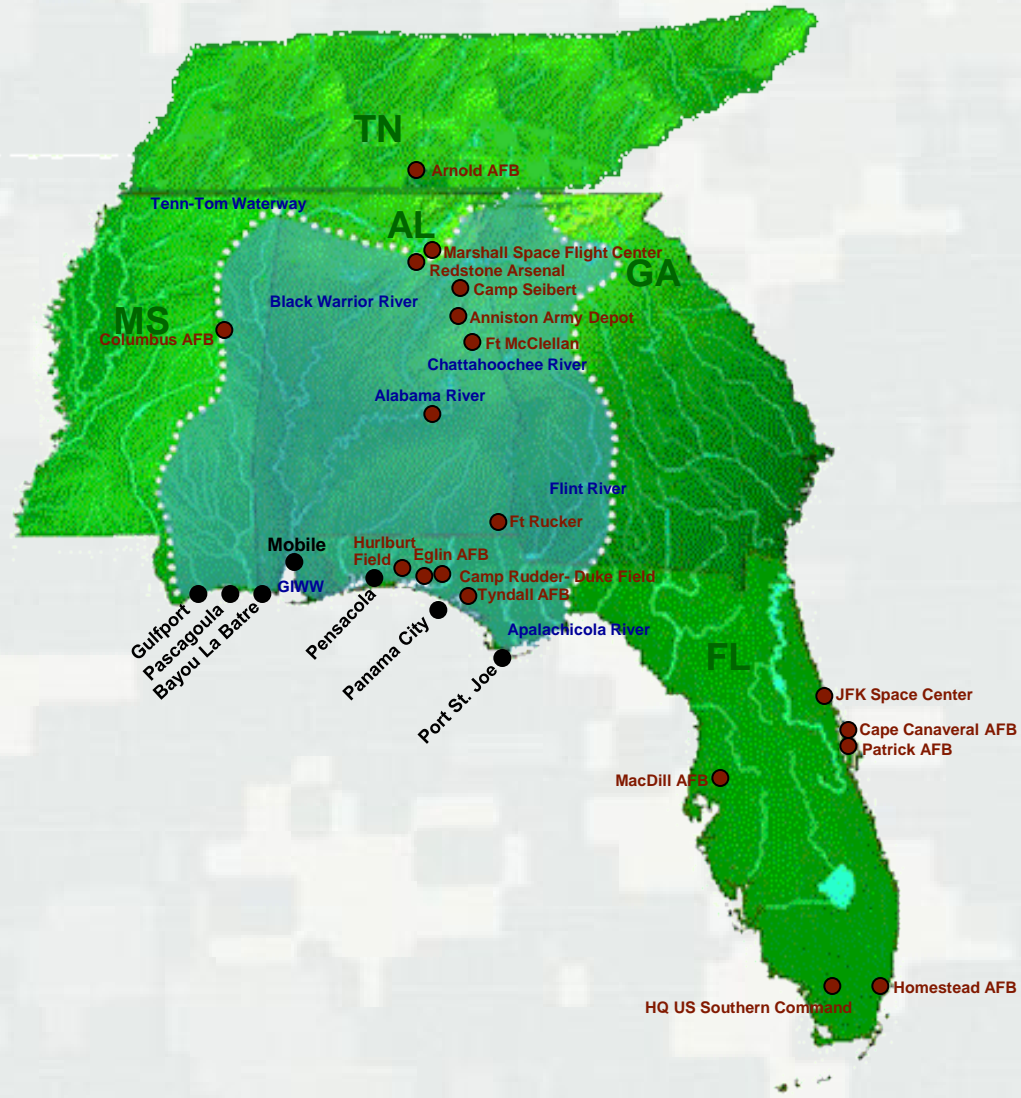


# **Mobile District IIS/SFO Mission**

- **Hit \$300M in total CONUS IIS workload.**



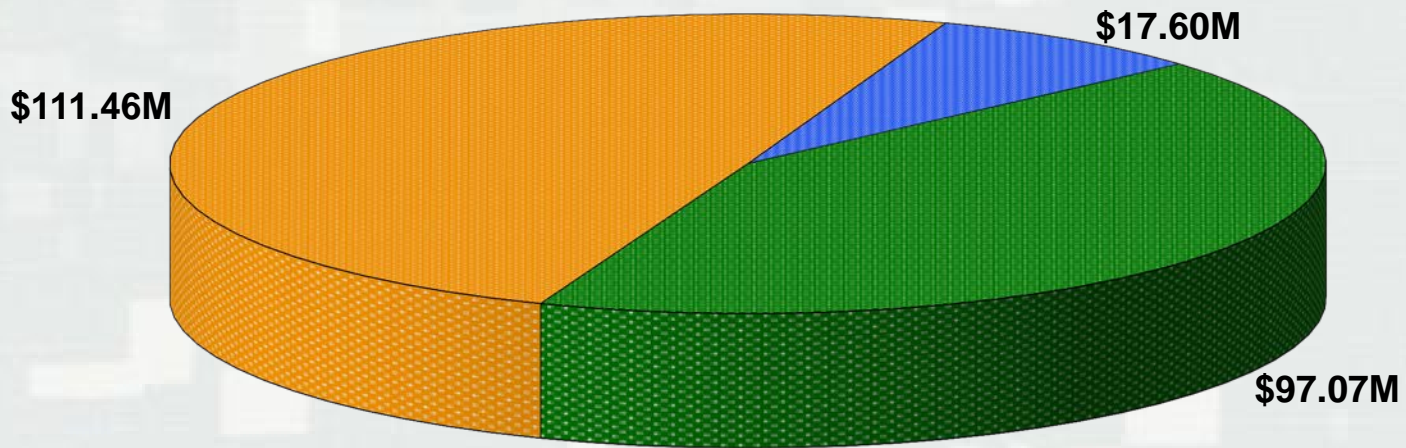
# Contract Methods for IIS

- **Construction**
  - Regional Unrestricted MATOC's
  - SATOC's (Small Business, 8a, Hubzone)
  - 8a (if less than \$4M)
  - Unrestricted/Restricted Type "C"
- **Design**
  - Normal Pool of AE IDIQ Contracts

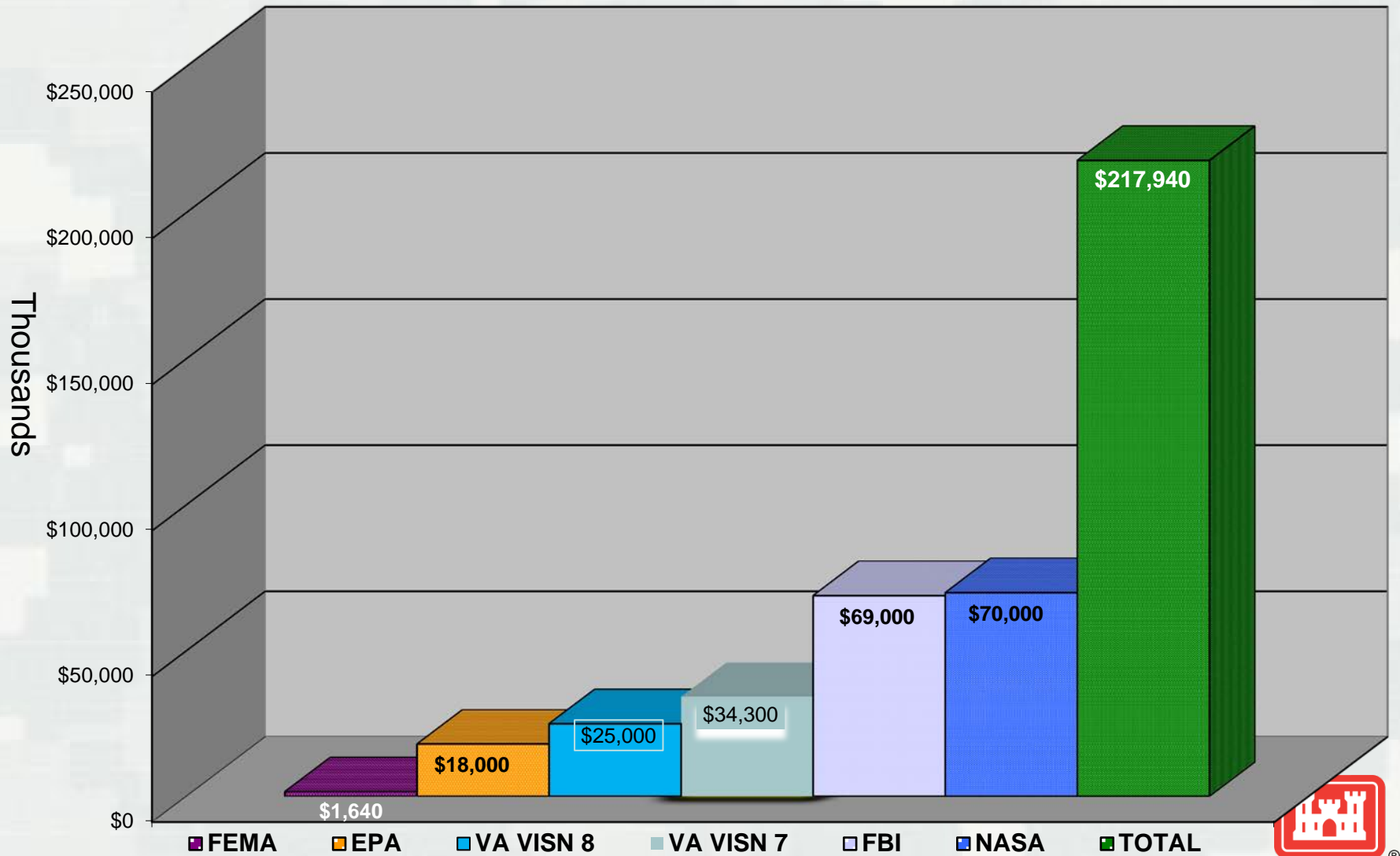

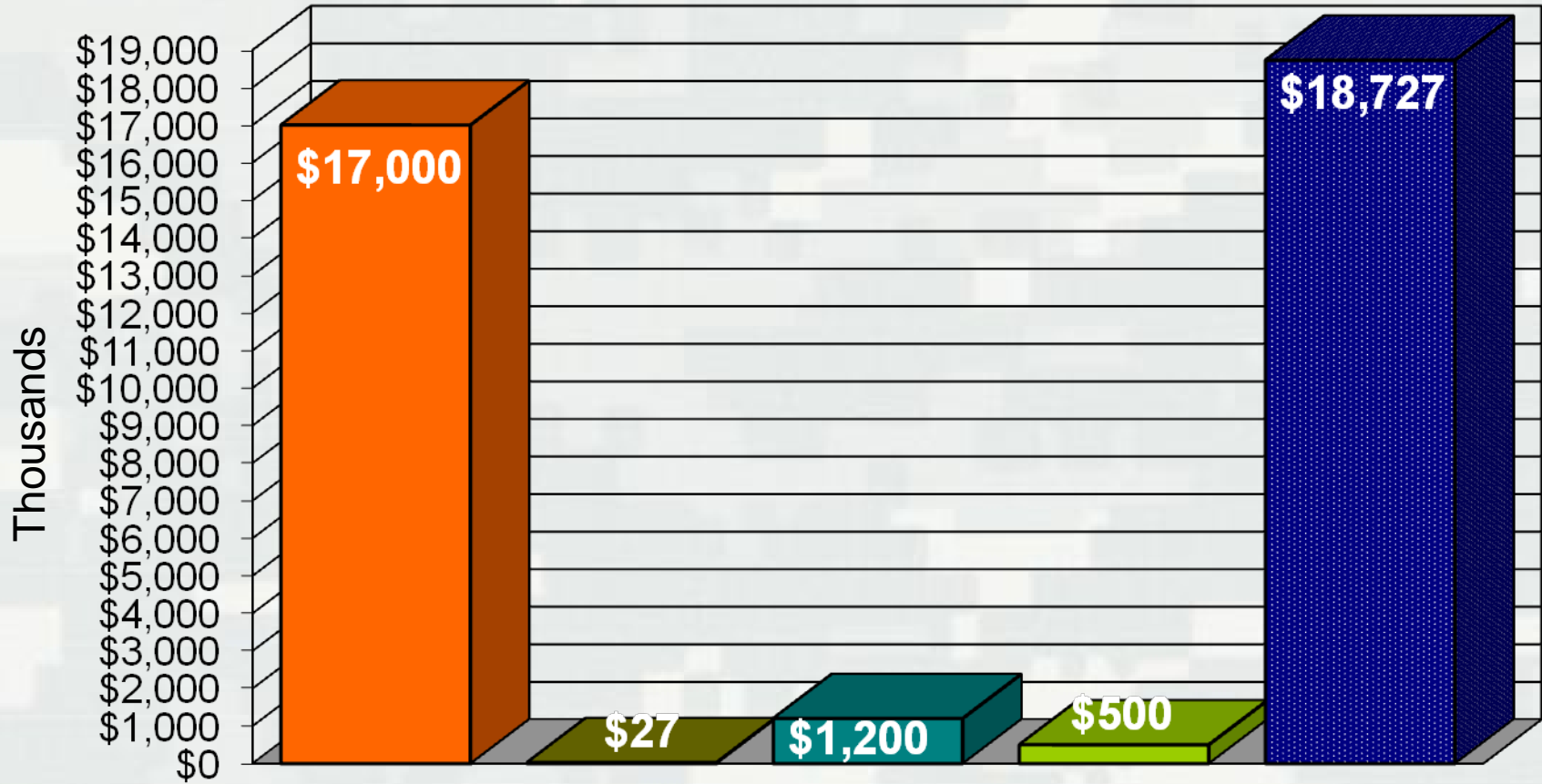

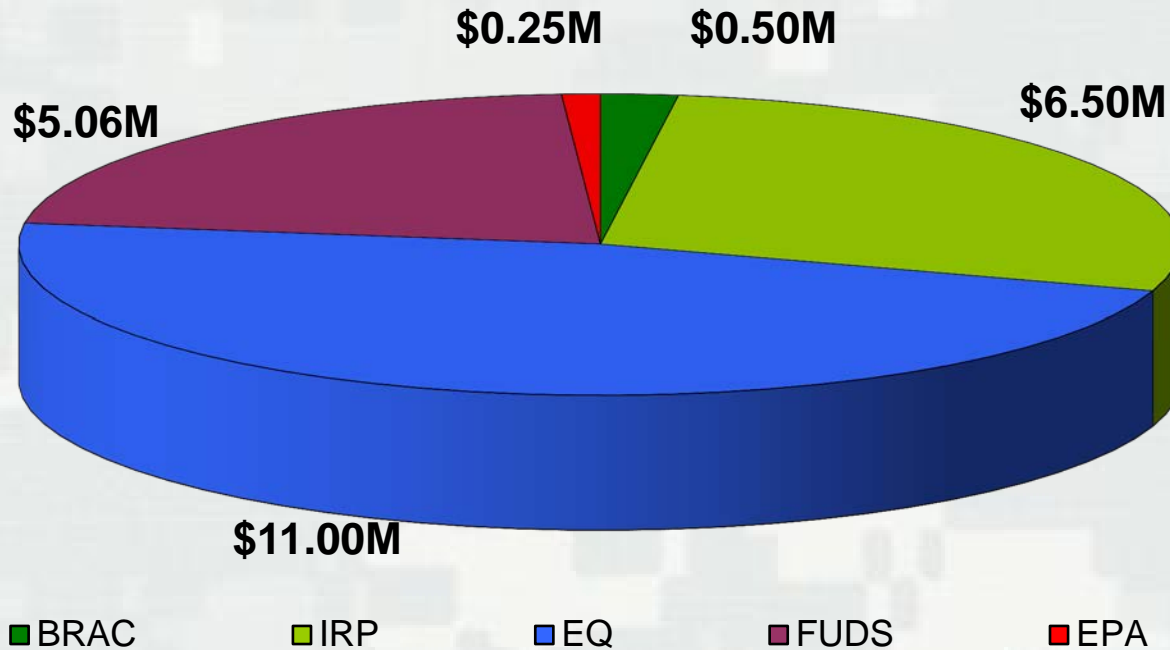
