# Army BRAC 2005 NEPA Program

- Mobile District charged with preparation of all Army BRAC 05 NEPA documents and supporting studies
- Program initiated in September 2005
- New construction for BRAC 05 was complete on 15 September 2011. NEPA for BRAC 05 property disposal actions is ongoing.
- 122 NEPA documents have been completed
  - ▶ 11 EISs
  - ▶ 111 EAs
- 30 EAs for property disposal actions are currently underway
- NEPA documentation for BRAC 2005 disposal actions should be complete in FY12 or early FY13
- We are hearing rumors of potential future BRAC actions but have seen nothing concrete at this time



# Privatization of Army Lodging

- The Army is privatizing all its lodging facilities nationwide
- Mobile District is preparing all NEPA and ECPs for the PAL program
- PAL is being executed in 3 groups
- Environmental documentation for Group A (10 installations) and Group B (11 installations) is complete
- Group C (21 installations) is now being kicked off and should be complete early in FY13

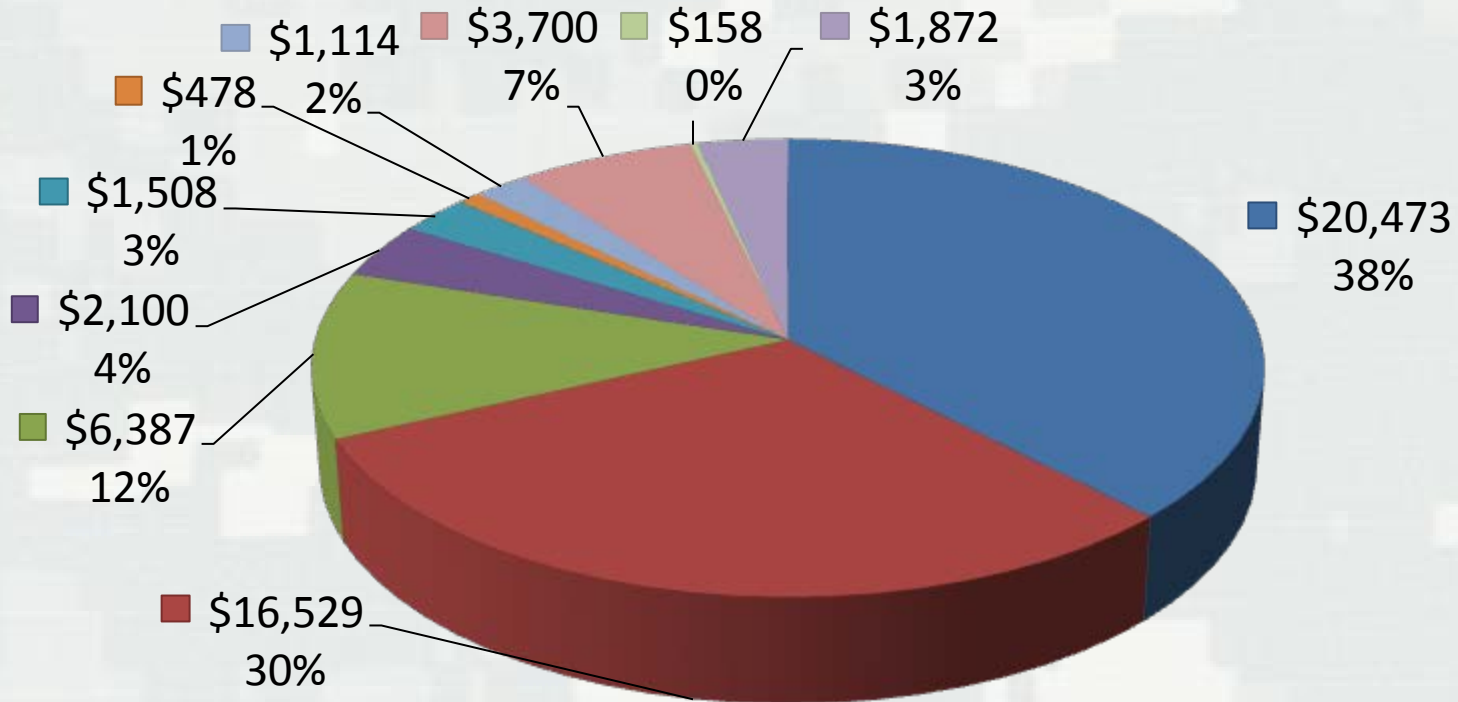

# Future Workload

- Support to traditional SAM customers
  - ▶ **Active Army**
  - ▶ **U.S. Air Force**
  - ▶ **U.S. Army National Guard**
  - ▶ **U.S. Army Reserves**
- Support to non-traditional customers such as NIH and DOE
- New environmental sustainability initiatives tied to EO 13514 and other DOD environmental policy requirements



# Contract Procurements

- Selected 7 new AE contractors in early FY11 - \$50M total capacity
- We let task orders totaling over \$40M in FY11
- New requirement to prepare acquisition plan for AE contract procurements over \$10M
- AE contract advertisement this fall for \$10M – 3 unrestricted and 1 small business firms
- Later AE contract package for \$250M – mix of unrestricted and small business not yet determined
