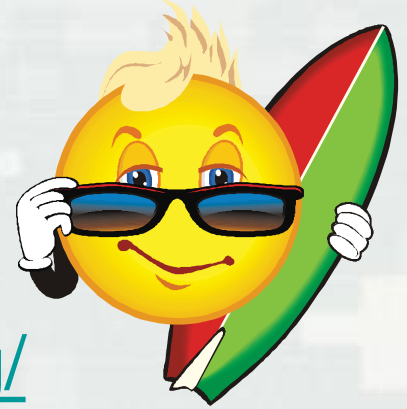

- Net Zero Initiatives



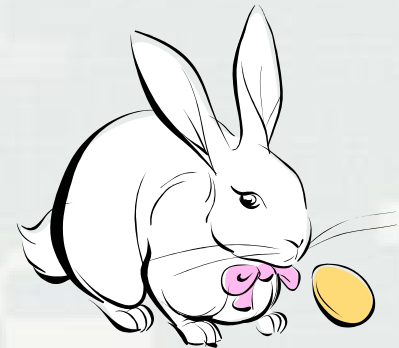
We Don't Make This Stuff Up

- SCA over 100K must be signed by SES or General Officer
- Compliance With Security Requirements
- Acquisition Strategy and Acquisition Plan must be approved prior to solicitation

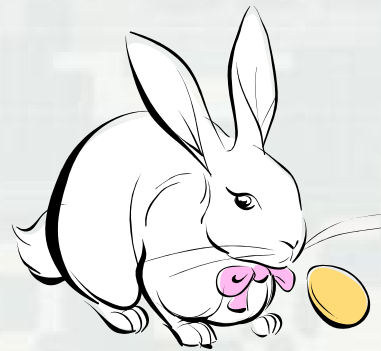
Performance Based Acquisition for Environmental Remediation
