26 August – Billboards to Renewable Energy in Florida

Robert B. Switzer, Vice President of operations of Lamar Advertising, will be presenting on Lamar's project to convert approximately 1,370 billboards throughout Florida to renewable energy. The \$12.5-million project consists of installing a total of one Megawatt (1,000 kilowatts) of renewable energy generation in the form of solar or wind power on 1,370 separate billboard structures in eight markets from Pensacola to Daytona and Tallahassee to Fort Myers. The installations are being installed on billboards along interstates and major thoroughfares, giving the project the widest public exposure. The U.S. Department of Energy is providing a \$2.5-million grant to the project through the Florida Energy and Climate Commission and the Governor's Energy Office, while Lamar is funding the remaining \$10 million.
