#### Flight Academy

The National Flight Academy teaches the principles of science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) with an immersive, hands-on approach that reaches far beyond the traditional academic experience. Students in 7th- 12th grades spend 5 ½ days undergoing an intensive course that combines classroom fundamentals with virtual reality. In this high-tech adventure like no other, students—dubbed Aviators—join a squadron and immediately begin planning and executing missions based on real-world events.
