JANUARY MEETING

Speaker: Bill Klepac, P.E., LCDR, CEC, USNR

Topic: OICC Det Iraq and the I MEF Engineer Group - Operation Iraqi Freedom II

LCDR Bill Klepac is a reserve Civil Engineer Corps Officer who served as Team Leader, Fallujah Detachment, NAVFAC Atlantic, Officer in Charge of Construction (OICC), Detachment Iraq from March through October 2004. In this capacity, LCDR Klepac led a team of five personnel, including two contracting officers, through the award and execution of over 60 contracts valued at over \$35 million. Most of these contracts were for infrastructure reconstruction and improvements for the area surrounding Fallujah and some were for facilities improvements to Camp Fallujah, headquarters to the I Marine Expeditionary Force (I MEF) and the I MEF Engineer Group (I MEG). LCDR Klepac's presentation will include a discussion of both the OICC and I MEG missions, the OICC Program and the general situation in the Anbar Province during OIF II.
