Captain Gerald R. Manley assumed command of the Officer In Charge of Construction, Ivan, Pensacola, FL on 01 December 2004.

Captain Manley was born in Charleston, West Virginia, and raised in Alexandria, Virginia. He received a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the Virginia Military Institute in 1981 and a Master of Engineering (Environmental) from the University of Florida, Gainesville, in 1992.

Captain Manley was commissioned via the Navy Reserve Officer Training Corps program in May 1981. After commissioning, he entered the Submarine Service and was assigned to the USS NATHAN HALE (SSBN 623(B)) home ported in Charleston, South Carolina, where he served as Assistant Weapons Officer. In 1985, he was granted a lateral transfer into the Navy's Civil Engineer Corps.

Captain Manley's additional duty assignments included: Assistant Resident Officer-In-Charge of Construction, Gulfport, Mississippi; Assistant Public Works Officer, Naval Air Station, Whiting Field, Milton, Florida; Graduate Student, University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida; Military Construction and Base Realignment and Closure Officer, Chief of Naval Education and Training, Pensacola, Florida; Contracts Department Head, Navy Public Works Center, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; Fleet Environmental Officer, Commander in Chief, Pacific Fleet, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; Executive Officer, Engineering Field Activity Northeast, Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Lester, Pennsylvania; and Executive Director, Navy Crane Center, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Lester, Pennsylvania.

Captain Manley is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Alabama and a member of the Navy's Acquisition Professional Community. His personal awards and decorations include four Meritorious Service Medals, four Navy Commendation Medals, the Navy Achievement Medal, and the Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal. He is qualified as a Submarine Warfare Officer and authorized to wear the Submarine Strategic Patrol Pin with one silver and one gold star.
